





 Voters can track ballots and receive text and email alerts


Mobile Vote Center

Election Statistics



Ballots Received = 40% Turnout

2024: 174,122 Ballots Received

Vote Patterns

Vote by Mail Ballots: 163,240

Vote Center Ballots: 10,882

VBM Returned Before Election Day: 55.7%

Vote Center Votes Before Election Day: 20.3%

Challenged Ballots

Most common reason Too Late: 2,374

All other reasons: 432

Percent challenged: 1.78%

Ballots cured: 567



Crossover Ballots



No Party Preference (NPP) voters received a nonpartisan ballot without presidential candidates unless they requested to crossover to vote for president in one of three open party primaries.

107,138 Registered as NPP

6,004 Democratic 589 American Independent 113 Libertarian

6,706 Total Crossover Ballots Requested

1. Vote by Mail: 33%


2. Voter Registration: 16%
